The garden tour will include 7 unique gardens for your viewing pleasure:

Historic Tallman Hotel and Blue Wing Restaurant gardens

Walking through the gardens of the historic Tallman Hotel, built in the 1890's, is to enjoy a myriad of unusual plants and flowering shrubs. The effect is one of Mediterranean winecountry charm.

Dana and Glenn's garden

Romantic English cottage style gardens meander around the old Queen Victorian home built in the 1890's. All are surrounded by organic Sauvignon Blanc vineyards. Original to the house are trees, shrubs and flowering plants common to the Victorian era including many beautiful old roses. Statues commissioned by famous artists are among the many pleasures or this historic garden.

Jerry and Josephine's garden

Jerry and Jo built this charming home in an old walnut orchard. Over the years deer, droughts and diminished well water made it necessary to choose deer-resistant and drought-tolerant plant material, especially indigenous natives. This garden maintains a peaceful and natural feeling.

Karl and Jane's garden

Art and function come together exquisitely in this garden. You'll see amazingly creative structures, handmade garden art, stone containers and a custom hothouse. The Mediterranean style "potager" garden produces all year utilizing organic and bio-intensive methods. *Plant sale at this garden

Wayne's garden

Wayne,s impressive home has a "commanding" view of the valley and Clear Lake below. The grounds have been wonderfully landscaped, the most impressive of which is the palm nursery. Note the zone we are in and the species that are adaptable. This collection is a great contribution of "Island" beauty to our community.

Debra 's garden

This home, built as a traditional French farmhouse, is situated on over 40 acres includes a 70-year-old organic walnut orchard. A fenced garden features organic year round produce. In the heirloom fruit orchard note the many honey producing trees and plants chosen for the honey bees. The swimming pool is surrounded by a perennial flower garden and a grape arbor. A pair of Toulouse geese might greet you!
